All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, being known and designated as Lot #10 of Block F, of Judson Mills #2 Village and shown on Plat by Dalton & Neves, March 1939, and recorded in Plat Book "K", Pages 1 and 2, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
