All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, partly within but mostly without the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, and being known and designated as Lot No. 6 on Plat of property of Parrish & Gower, recorded in Plat Book E, page 136, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and being more particularly described according to Survey and Plat of Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, dated November 7, 1944, as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the Northeast side of Augusta Street, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 5 and 6; thence with line of said Lots, N. 42-07 E. 180.2 feet to a stake on a 15 foot alley; thence with said alley, S. 71-45 E. 35 feet to a stake; thence with said alley, S. 73-24 E. 31.1 feet to a stake; thence S. 42-07 W. 207.6 feet with joint line of Lots Nos. 6 and 7 to a stake on Augusta Street; thence with said Street, N. 47-03 W. 60 feet to the beginning.
