Thomson in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to us in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said C. E. Robinson, As Trustee

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina lying and being on the east side of the White Horse Road and being known and designated as Lot No. 24 of Map No. 2 of Camilla Park Sub-Division as shown on plat thereof by W. J. Riddle, dated December 1943 recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book A, page 85 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the east side of the White Horse Road which iron pin is 160 feet south of the intersection of White Horse Road and Daniel Avenue and is also the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 23 and 24; thence S. 84-44 E. 200 feet to an iron pin joint corner Lots Nos. 23, 24, 45 and 46; thence S. 9-16 W. 80 feet to an iron pin joint corner Lots Nos. 24, 25, 44 and 45; thence N. 20-44 W. 200 feet to an iron pin on the east side of the white horse Road joint front corner Lot No. 24; thence N. 9-16 E. 80 feet to the beginning corner.
