-----Dollars to be paid **on demand after date**

with interest thereon from **date**

at the rate of **6** per centum per annum, to be computed and paid **semi-annually**

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

The Pelzer-Williamston Bank, its successors and assigns forever;

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Oaklawn Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about two miles South of Pelzer, on the East side of Holland's Ford Road, and being known and designated as Tract No. 10, of the property of the Estate of Narcissus N. Anderson, as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book E. pages 74 to 77, and containing 42 acres, more or less, and being more particularly described as follows;

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Holland's Ford Road, said point being in the center of said road, and running thence along the center of said road, N. 46 3/4 W. 775 feet to an iron pin in the center of said road; thence N. 41 E. 2365 feet to a stake; thence S. 50 E. 681 feet to a point on the North bank of Grove Creek, said line passing through a red oak and a poplar; thence along the center of Grove Creek as the line to a point near three sweet gum trees; thence S. 17 W. 71 feet to a point; thence S. 73 W. 700 feet to a point; thence S. 39 W. 1652 feet to the beginning corner.
