S. Brockman, Surveyor, dated November 16, 1933, and amended by a survey of W. J. Riddle under date of March 12, 1941 and being bounded by lands now or formerly of Pierce Hughes on the north, John Holland on the east, and Mrs. Black on the south and west. It is fully described by courses and distances on the amended Brockman plat recorded in Plat Book Page 71 R. M. C. Office, Greenville County. It is the same tract of land conveyed to C. B.
