To All Whom These Presents May Concern

I, George A. Robinson,

hereinafter spoken of as the Mortgagor send greeting.

Whereas I, George A. Robinson, am

justly indebted to C. Douglas Wilson & Co., a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of South Carolina, hereinafter spoken of as the Mortgagee, in the sum of Seventy-Eight Hundred & No/100 - - - - - Dollars

(\$ 7800.00), lawful money of the United States which shall be legal tender in payment of all debts and dues, public and private, at the time of payment, secured to be paid by that one certain bond or obligation, bearing even date herewith, conditioned for payment at the principal office of the said C. Douglas Wilson & Co., in the City of Greenville, S. C., or at such other place either within or without the State of South Carolina, as the owner of this obligation may from time to time designate, of the sum of Seventy-Eight Hundred & No/100 - - - - - Dollars (\$ 7800.00)

with interest thereon from the date hereof at the rate of Four per centum per annum, said interest to be paid on the 1st day of October 19 48 and thereafter said interest and principal sum to be paid in installments as follows: Beginning on the 1st day of November 19 48, and on the 1st day of each month thereafter the sum of \$ 47.26 to be applied on the interest and principal of said note, said payments to continue up to and including the 1st day of September 19 68, and the balance of said principal sum to be due and payable on the 1st day of October 19 68, the aforesaid monthly payments of \$ 47.26 each are to be applied first to interest at the rate

of Four per centum per annum on the principal sum of \$ 7800.00 or so much thereof as shall from time to time remain unpaid and the balance of each monthly payment shall be applied on account of principal. Said principal and interest to be paid at the par of exchange and net to the obligee, it being thereby expressly agreed that the whole of the said principal sum shall become due after default in the payment of interest, taxes, assessments, water rate or insurance, as hereinafter provided.

Now, Know All Men, that the said Mortgagor in consideration of the said debt and sum of money mentioned in the condition of the said bond and for the better securing the payment of the said sum of money mentioned in the condition of the said bond, with the interest thereon, and also for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar in hand paid by the said Mortgagee, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, conveyed and released and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, convey and release unto the said Mortgagee and to its successors, legal representatives and assigns forever, all that parcel, piece or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and is shown as an unplatted portion of East Lynne Addition, as per plat thereof recorded in Plat Book H, at Page 220 in the R.M.C. Office for said County, and is designated as the property of George A. Robinson, according to a survey made by R.E. Dalton, Registered Engineer, September, 1948, recorded in said Office in Plat Book "U", at Page 177 on September 24, 1948. According to the latter mentioned plat the said lot has the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeastern side of Laurens Road, which iron pin is 365.3 feet in a Southeasterly direction from the Southeastern intersection of Laurens Road and Simmons Avenue, and running thence along the line of the Klugh property N. 59-10 E. 200 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 30-50 E. 65.4 feet to an iron pin in the line of the property now or formerly owned by Lipscombe; thence along the line of the Lipscombe property S. 59-10 W. 200 feet to an iron pin in the line of Laurens Road; thence along the Northeastern side of Laurens Road N. 30-50 W. 65.4 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
