BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Westerly side of Sunset Drive, which iron pin is 600 feet in a Northwesterly direction from Waccamaw Avenue, joint corner of lots Nos. 84 and 85; thence along the joint line of said lots S. 48-50 W. 191.6 feet to an iron pin in the line of a 5 foot strip reserved for utilities; thence along said 5 foot strip reserved for utilities N. 41-10 W. 167.1 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 27-58 E. 96.3 feet to an iron pin, rear joint corner of lots Nos. 85 and 86; thence along the joint line of said lots N. 86-41 E. 199.3 feet to an iron pin in the line of Sunset Drive; thence around a curve on the Westerly side of Sunset Drive (the chord of which is S. 8-15 E.) 75 feet to the point of beginning.
