All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, located on the Eastern side of Flora Avenue, and known and designated as Lot #75 of Camilla Park #2, a plat of which is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "M", at page 35, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, courses and distances to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Eastern side of Flora Avenue 250 feet from the Southeastern intersection of Flora and Daniel Avenues, joint corner of Lots #74 and 75, and running thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 80-44 E. 200 feet to an iron pin, rear joint corner of said lots; thence S. 9-16 W. 80 feet to an iron pin, rear joint corner of Lots #75 and 76; thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 80-44 W. 200 feet to an iron pin in the line of Flora Avenue; thence along the Eastern side of Flora Avenue, N. 9-16 E. 80 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
