

S. 70-09 E. 21.45 feet to a point on the West side of the 12-foot alley hereinabove referred to; thence along the West side of said 12-foot alley (a portion of which distance runs along the East side of the wall building on the property herein conveyed) S. 19-46 W. 101 feet to the beginning corner.
