Beginning at a stake; corner of an $8\frac{1}{2}$ foot alley, said stake being $98\frac{1}{2}$ feet northeast of corner of E. North Street and Brown Street; thence S. 69-15 E. being the north line of said alley, 123 feet to stake which is 20 feet from the line of J. F.
