NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and the order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagor and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the reserve whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Paris Mountain Township, on the Southern side of Floyd Street, near the City of Greenville, and according to survey made by Pickell and Pickell on August 26, 1948, is described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a stake on the Southern side of Floyd Street, approximately 197 feet East from Thompson Road, at corner of property of Carl Floyd, and running thence with line of said property, S. 1-28 E. 306.7 feet to a stake; thence S. 68-5 E. 75 feet to a stake; thence N. 8-10 E. 322.7 feet to a stake on the South side of Floyd Street; thence with the South side of Floyd Street, N. 81-50 W. 110 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner. Being the same property conveyed to the mertgagor by Carl Floyd by deed dated August 30, 1947, recorded in Volume 360 at Page 433.
