"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, together with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in that area recently annexed to the City of Greenville, in County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the South side of East North Street Extension (formerly Old Spartanburg Road), being shown as Part of Let Extension (formerly Old Spartanburg Road), being shown as Part of Let Cureton, August 21, 1920, which plat is recorded in the R.M.C. Office, Greenville County, S.C. in Plat Book "F" at page 76, and having according to a recent survey and plat of Property of John F. Chandler, prepared by Dalton & Neves, Engs., in August, 1948, the same being shown on said plat as the Nothernmost part thereof, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Extension at the Northwest corner of a 10.2 foot alley, and running thence along the West side of said alley, S. 31-20 E. 95.1 feet to an iron pin at the Northeast corner of property of Henry H. Hersey; thence along Northern edge of said Hersey property, S. 55-35 W. 47.1 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 32-34 W. 106.9 feet to an iron pin on the South Side of East North Street Extension, which pin is 2 feet N. 69-16 E. from the Northeast corner of property now or formerly owned by Rhinehardt; thence along the South side of East North Street Extension, N. 69-16 E. 49.7 feet to point of beginning.
