To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

I, Richard S. Eassy, of Greenville County SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I the said Richard S. Eassy

in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents, well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, in the full and just sum of EIGHT THOUSAND, FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100 - - (\$8,500.00)

Dollars, with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of SEVENTY-TWO AND NO/100 - - (\$ 72.00) Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Richard S. Eassy

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me,

the said Richard S. Eassy in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Greenville Township, in Ward Six of the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 61, Section A, of a subdivision known as Cagle Park according to a plat of the property of Wilkins Cagle prepared by J. E. Serrine, Engineer, November 3, 1914, recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book C, at page 195, and having, according to a more recent plat of Pickell and Pickell, Engineers, dated August 30, 1944, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at a point in a concrete wall on the North side of Tindal avenue at the joint front corners of Lots Nos. 60 and 61, and running thence with the line of said lots, N. 3-28 W. 200 feet to a post on the South side of McKay street; thence with said street, N. 87-49 E. 60 feet to a post; thence with the line of Lot No. 62, S. 3-25 E. 199.7 feet to a stake on the North side of Tindal avenue; thence with the North side of said avenue, S. 87-40 W. 60 feet to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to me by Sue Smith Forrester by deed of even date herewith not yet recorded."
