

And the said mortgagors agree to insure the house and premises... than Fifteen Hundred and No/100... in a company or companies satisfactory to the mortgagee... damage by fire, and assign the policy of insurance to the said mortgagee... the mortgagor shall at any time fail to do so, then this said mortgage... insured in our name and residence itself for the premium and expense of such insurance under this mortgage with interest.

And if at any time any part of said debt, or interest thereon, be past due and unpaid, we do hereby assign the rents and profits of the above described premises to said mortgagee, or its successors, Executors, Administrators or Assigns, and agree that any Judge of the Circuit Court of said State may, at chambers or otherwise, appoint a receiver, with authority to take possession of said premises and collect said rents and profits, applying the net proceeds thereof (after paying costs of collection) upon said debt, interest, costs or expenses; without liability to account for anything more than the rents and profits actually collected.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, nevertheless, and it is the true intent and meaning of the parties to these Presents, that if we, the said mortgagors, do and shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said mortgagee the debt or sum of money aforesaid, with interest thereon, if any be due, according to the true intent and meaning of the said note, then this deed of bargain and sale shall cease, determine, and be utterly null and void; otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.

AND IT IS AGREED by and between the said parties that said mortgagors are to hold and enjoy the said Premises until default of payment shall be made.
