All that certain parcel or tract of land containing ten and two-tenths (10.2) acres, more or less, in Oaklawn Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, more particularly described on plat prepared by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, dated December, 1948, as follows: Begin at the Southeast corner of the property described in said mortgage and run North 79 degrees West 660 feet, thence North 41 degrees 25 minutes West 75 feet; thence North 22 degrees East 625.5 feet to State Highway No. 3; thence along said highway South 70 degrees 25 minutes East 761 feet to a county road; thence along the county road South 26 degrees West 556.5 feet to the point of beginning.
