with interest thereon from date at the rate of 4½ per centum per annum, said principal machinesses to be repaid: In monthly installments of \$17.00 each on the 20th day of each month hereafter, said payments to be applied first to interest and then to principal until paid in full, with the privilege of anticipating payments on any interest paying date; provided, that the total payments shall not exceed \$300.00 in any one year, and with the privilege of paying the loan in full on payment of 1% of theoriginal amount, with interest thereon from date, to be computed and paid monthly.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagoe at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagoe pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, his heirs, successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Greenville Township, on the Northern side of Augusta Road, and being more fully described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a point on the Northern side of Augusta Road, 185.3 feet Northwest from Oregon Street, and running thence N. 35-44 E. 216.2 feet to a stake; thence N. 41-28 W. 47 feet to a stake, corner of property now or formerly owned by L. E. and Corrie Arnold; thence with the line of said property in a Northwesterly direction, 237 feet, more or less, to a stake on the Northeast side of Augusta Road; thence with the Northeastern side of said road, S. 55-56 E. 118 feet to the beginning corner."
