"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Paris Mountain Township, on the North side of the Saluda River, about six miles from the City of Greenville, adjoining lands now or formerly of W. H. Willimon, William Farr and the Bruce Estate, and being the major pertien of a tract of land conveyed to R. E. Griffin by C. L. Willimon by deed dated March 28, 1938, recorded in Book 202 at Page 438. The lands here conveyed are shown on a Plat made by Perry B. Wilson, Jr., Surveyor, to have the following courses and distances:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin in Farr Bridge Read, on line between Willimon and Means, and running thence N. 36 W. 445.5 feet to a pine above spring; thence 313.5 feet to a maple 3xom at the head of spring; thence with the meanderings of spring branch 686.4 feet to a stake at the meuth of spring branch; thence S. 16-15 W. 61.1 feet to a white eak 3xom; thence S. 6-15 W. 330.0 feet to a beech 3xom; thence down and with the meanderings of the Saluda River above high water mark 1000.0 feet, more or less, to a corner (not marked); thence S. 74-59 E. 100.0 feet, more or less, to an iron pin on edge of eddy water; thence continuing with said line 206.3 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 73-46 E. 241.0 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 0-25 W. 582.4 feet to a point in the center of Farr Bridge Road; thence up and with the angle of said road to the beginning corner, containing 35.5 acres, more or less; being the same premises conveyed to the mortgagor by R. E. Griffin by deed recorded in Book of Deeds 284 at Page 298."
