with interest thereon from date at the rate of six per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid: In monthly installments of \$40.00 each on the 9th day of each month hereafter to be applied first to interest and then to principal until paid in full

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagor at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagoe pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, his heirs, successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Bates Township, in the Town of Travelers Rest, S. C., being known and designated as lot No. 21 on a Plat of Love Estates recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "C", at Pages 111 and 112, and being more particularly described as follows:

"BEGINNING on the Buncombe Road at the rear corner of lot No. 22 at a point 257 feet Southeast from the fork of the Buncombe Road and the School House Road, and running thence along the rear line of lot No. 22, N. 44-50 W. 141.4 feet to the School House Road; thence along said School House Road, S. 64 W. 101.4 feet to lot No. 23; thence along the line of lots Nos. 23 and 20, S. 44-50 E. 200 feet to the Buncombe Road; thence along said Buncombe Road, N. 29-40 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner."
