Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book H, at pages 133-134, and having when described together, according to a recent survey and plat of property of Harrison S. Forrester, made by Piedmont Engineering Service, January 27, 1949, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Westerly side of Riverside Drive at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 52 and 53, and running thence along joint line of said lots S. 47-30 W. 221.2 feet to an iron pin on the Easterly edge of a 10-foot strip reserved for utilities; thence along the Easterly edge of said strip S. 54-40 E. 61.1 feet to an iron pin on the Northerly side of Brookside Way; thence with Northerly side of Brookside Way N. 68-46 E. 69.2 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along said Brookside Way along a curving course (the chord of which is N. 63-42 E.)79 ft topin; thence continuing along the curve of Brookside Way (the chord of which is N. 21-20 E) 45.9 feet to iron pin on the Westerly side of Riverside Drive; thence along a curving course along the Westerly side of Riverside Drive (the chord of which is N. 17-33 W.) 40.6 feet to iron pin; thence continuing along the Resterly side of Riverside Drive along a curving course (the chord of which is N. 32-09 W.) 49.1 feet to iron pin, the point of beginning.
