We, William C. Stone and Dorothy E. Stone, of Greenville
County, South Carolina SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, we the said William C. Stone and Dorothy E. Stone

in and by OUR certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents are well and truly indebted to Canal Insurance Company
in the full and just sum of Thirty-six Hundred Fifty & no/100
(\$ 2650.00) DOLLARS, to be paid at Canal Ins. Co. office, in Greenville, S. C., together with interest thereon from July 1, 1946 until maturity at the rate of four (4%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest being payable in monthly installments as follows:

Beginning on the 1st day of August, 1946 and on the 1st day of each month of each year thereafter the sum of \$ 22.12, to be applied on the interest and principal of said note, said payments to continue up to and including the 1st day of July, 1966 and the balance of said principal and interest to be due and payable on the 1st day of July, 1966 the aforesaid 22.12 payments of \$ 22.12 each are to be applied first to interest at the rate of four (4%) per centum per annum on the principal sum of \$ 3,650.00 or so much thereof as shall, from time to time, remain unpaid and the balance of each monthly payment shall be applied on account of principal.

All installments of principal and all interest are payable in lawful money of the United States of America; and in the event default is made in the payment of any installment or installments, or any part hereof, as herein provided, including any past due taxes or insurance premiums, the same shall bear simple interest from the date of such default until paid at the rate of four per centum per annum.

And if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, or if default be made in respect to any condition, agreement or covenant contained herein, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder thereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity, it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of its interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including ten (10%) per cent, of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That we, the said William C. Stone and Dorothy E. Stone, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Canal Insurance Company according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of THREE DOLLARS, to us, the said William C. Stone and Dorothy E. Stone, in hand and truly paid by the said Canal Insurance Company at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt thereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Canal Insurance Company, its successors, and assigns:

All that certain lot of land situate, lying and being on the West side of Bates Street, (also known as Furman Road), County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as lot No. 5 of property of Central Realty Corporation according to a plat of said property made by Pickell & Pickell, April 30, 1946, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for said Greenville County in Plat Book L, Page 57, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING- at a point o the West side of said Bates Street (Furman Road) at the joint corner of lots Nos. 4 and 5, and running thence along said Bates Street (Furman Road), S. 32-26 W. 50 feet to a point on the West side of said Street which is the joint corner of lots Nos. 5 and 6; thence along the joint line of said lots Nos. 5 and 6, N. 57-34 W. 140 feet to a point which is the joint rear corner of said lots Nos. 5 and 6; thence N. 42-59 E. 50.9 feet to a point which is the joint rear corner of lots Nos. 4 and 5; thence along the joint line of said lots Nos. 4 and 5, S. 57-34 E. 130.6 feet to a point on the West side of said Bates Street or Furman Road, which is the joint corner of said lots Nos. 4 and 5, the point of beginning.
