NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, in Ward 5 of the City of Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

**BEGINNING at a point on the West side of Lawton Avenue, 259½ feet from Perry Avenue at corner of property now or formerly owned by J. H. Berry, and running thence along Lawton Avenue, H. 17-30 E. 54½ feet; thence N. 71-30 W. 173 feet; thence S. 17-30 W. 54½ feet; thence South along line of property now or formerly belonging to J. H. Berry, S. 71-30 E. 173 feet to the beginning corner."

Said premises being the same conveyed to the mortgagor by E. Inman, Master, by deed dated June 6, 1931, recorded in Book of Deeds 149 at Page 586.
