"All that certain piece, percel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the Village of S. Slater & Sons, Inc., at Slater, on the West side of Mellon Street, being known and designated as lot No. 1 of Block I, as shown on plat of the Village of S. Slater & Sons, Inc., made by J. E. Sirrine & Company, Engineers, on July 10th, 1940, which Plat is recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book E at Pages 63, 64 and 65, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

\*\*\*BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of Mellon Street, joint corner of lets Nos. 1 and 2 of Black I, and running thence with Mellon Street, S. 10-58 E. 70 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 69-02 W. 110 feet to iron pin; thence M. 9-58 W. 95.8 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of lets Nos. 1 and 2; thence with the line of let No. 2, N. 82-36 E. 107.2 feet to beginning corner."
