whereof is hereby acknowledged, doth, by these presents, acknowledge, bind, and release unto the Mortgagor, its successors and assigns, the following-described
property situated in the town of Greenville,

State of South Carolina, in the city of Greenville, in School District 22D, and being
known as the corner lot on Adams Street, as shown on an unrecorded plat of Florence C.
Hill, Civil Engineer, 1928, and being more particularly de-
scribed in an instrument of record in the office of Plaintiff Engineering Service, dated May 5,
1949, as follows:

Beginning at the southwest corner at the Northwest intersection of Adams Street and
Stewart Street, and running thence with Adams Street, S. 53-52 W. 210.8 feet to an
iron pipe in ground, S. 53-52 W. 20.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 53-52 E. 225 feet
