"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, situate in Southeast corner of that certain lot of land shown on City Block Book, Section 2, Page 95, as being the property of J. P. Chappell, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
