Now, Know All Men, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being on the East side of Parkside Drive in that area recently annexed to the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, S. C., being shown as Lot No. 11, Block A on Plat of Northgate, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book M, page 13 and having according to said plat and a recent survey made by A. C. Crouch, Engineer, May 19, 1949 the following metes and bounds to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Parkside Drive at joint corner of Lots 10 and 11 of Block A, said pin being 150 feet South from the Southeast corner of intersection of Parkside Drive with Old Spartanburg Highway (also known as old U.S. Highway No. 29) and running thence along the line of Lots 9 and 10 N. 67-12 E. 149.2 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 20-15 E. 87.8 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Lot 12 S. 72-04 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the East side of Parkside Drive; thence along the East side of Parkside Drive (the chord being N. 19-38 W. 75 feet) to an iron pin the beginning corner.
