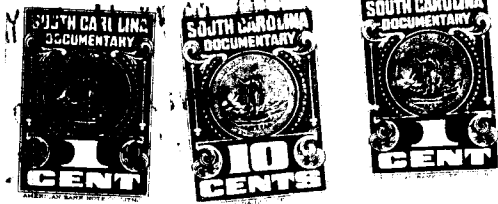

with interest thereon from Date

at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

R. and G. R. Richardson as shown by a plat made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor in April 1947, recorded in Plat Book "Q" page 159, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County. Said lot begins at an iron pin on the north side of Perry Street and runs thence N. 70-15 E. 164 ft. to iron pin on corner of lot #16; thence N. 19-45 W. 258 ft. to iron pin; thence S. 13-30 W. 305 ft. to the beginning corner, and being the same lot of land conveyed to mortgagor by Gladys K. Thackston by deed dated Dec. 7, 1948, recorded in Greenville County R. M. C. Office in Vol. 367, page 81.
