NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagoe at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagoe pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, his heirs, successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Greenville Township, on the Northwest side of Augusta Place, being shown as Lot No. 18 on Plat of Augusta Place, made by R. E. Dalton in May 1923, recorded in Plat Book F at Page 129, and described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a stake on the Northwest side of Augusta Place 120.4 feet Northeast from Fuller Street, at corner of Lot No. 17, and running thence with the line of said lot, N. 26-30 W. 198 feet to a stake; thence N. 63-30 E. 60 feet to a stake at corner of Lot No. 19; thence with the line of said lot, S. 26-30 E. 192.6 feet to a stake on Augusta Place; thence with the North side of Augusta Place, S. 58-30 W. 60.23 feet to the beginning corner." Martin, and running thence with said Godfrey line, S. 78-02 E. 225 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 11-58 E. 140 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 78-02 W. 225 feet to an iron pin on Waccamaw Avenue; thence with said Avenue, S. 11-58 W. 140 feet to the beginning corner." Said premises being the same conveyed to the mortgagor by deed to be recorded.
