NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said F. B. Massingale

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Dugald W. Hudson

All that certain lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the Braclott Road, being Lot No. 6 on plat of property of F. B. Massingale made by J. Coke Smith, May 15th, 1947, and having the following metes and bounds according to said plat:

BEGINNING at a stake on the north side of Arch Street Extension, at corner of Lot No. 7, and running thence in a northwesterly direction with line of Lot No. 7, 160 feet to a stake; thence S. 60-40 W. 60 feet to a stake at corner of Lot No. 5; thence with line of Lot No. 5 in a southeasterly direction 160 feet to a stake on the edge of Arch Street Extension; and thence in an easterly direction with the north side of Arch Street Extension 60 feet to the beginning corner.

The above described lot of land is a portion of the same conveyed to me by E. Inman, Master, by deed dated May 20, 1947, and recorded in Book 312, page 234.
