WE, MARY LUCILLE MCKINNEY AND MAUDIE MCKINNEY DIXON

SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, we the said Mary Lucille McKinney and Maudie McKinney Dixon

in and by our certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents are well and truly indebted to A. J. Timmons in the full and just sum of one thousand two hundred seventy five and no/100 dollars (\$ 1275.00) DOLLARS, to be paid at Canal Insurance Co. office Greenville, S. C. together with interest thereon from date hereof until maturity at the rate of six (6) per centum per annum, said principal and interest being payable in monthly installments as follows:

Beginning on the 15th day of September 1949 and on the 15th day of each month of each year thereafter the sum of \$ 20.00 to be applied on the interest and principal of said note, said payments to continue until paid in full and the balance of said principal and interest to be due and payable on the 15th day of each month the aforesaid monthly payments of \$ 20.00 interest at the rate of six (6) per centum per annum on the principal sum of \$ 1275.00 so much thereof as shall from time to time remain unpaid and the balance of each monthly payment shall be applied on account of principal.

All installments of principal and all interest are payable in lawful coin of the United States of America and in the event default is made in the payment of any installment or installments or any part thereof as herein provided including any past due taxes or insurance premiums, the same shall bear simple interest from the date of such default until paid at the rate of six (6) per centum per annum.

And if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, or should hereafter become so by operation, agreement or covenant contained herein, then the whole amount of principal and interest then due and payable at the option of the holder thereof, who may sue thereon and enforce the same, and the maturity of the same should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or to be done in conformity therewith, by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of its interests to place a lien on the property of the debtor, or to place the same in the hands of an attorney for legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the cost of such suit or suits, or of such proceedings and expenses including ten (10%) per centum thereon shall be borne by the debtor, and the holder of this note shall be bound to see that this provision is carried out.

of the sum of one hundred dollars (\$ 100.00) to Mary Lucille McKinney and Maudie McKinney Dixon of the sum of one hundred dollars (\$ 100.00) to A. J. Timmons

at and before the signing of these Presents, the said Mary Lucille McKinney and Maudie McKinney Dixon and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell, convey, confirm, ratify, release and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or lot of Land in or near the City of Greenville County, State of South Carolina, situate, lying and being on the North side of Durham Street in a section known as Block No. 4, of the City of Greenville, South Carolina, known and designated as lot No. 9 and 10, of the subdivision of property owned by Central Realty Corporation and by Fitchell & Pickell, June 20, 1946, recorded in R. M. C. Office for said Greenville County in Plat Book B, page 199, and having as a part of the said part the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at a point on Durham Street, joint corner of lots Nos. 9 and 10, according to said plat, and running thence with the joint line of said lots Nos. 9 and 10, N. 82-00 W. 150 feet to a point which is the joint rear corner of said lots Nos. 9 and 10; thence N. 69-30 E. 60 feet to a point, rear corner of said lot No. 10; thence S. 82-00 E. 150 feet to a point on the North side of Durham Street; thence along the said Durham Street, S. 69-30 W. 6. feet to the point of beginning, joint corner of said lots Nos. 9 and 10, on the North side of Durham Street.
