

...mortgagee agree to insure the house and buildings on said lot in a sum not less than **(\$5,000.00)** Dollars and keep the same insured from loss or damage by fire and lightning and to keep the policy of insurance to the said mortgagee and that in the event that the mortgagor shall fail to do so, then the said mortgagee may cause the same to be insured in **its** name and reimburse **itself** the premium and expense of such insurance under this mortgage, with interest.

...at any time any part of said debt, or interest thereon, be past due and unpaid, **I, G.F. Stewart** hereby assign the rents and profits of the above described premises to said mortgagee, or his Administrators or Assigns, and agree that any Judge of the Circuit Court of said State may, in his discretion, appoint a receiver, with authority to take possession of said premises and collect said rents and profits, applying the net proceeds thereafter (after paying costs of collection) upon said debt, without liability to account for anything more than the rents and profits actually received.

NOTWITHSTANDING ALWAYS, nevertheless, and it is the true intent and meaning of the parties to these Presents, that the said mortgagee do and shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said mortgagor the debt or sum of money aforesaid, with interest thereon, if any be due, according to the true intent and meaning of the said note, then this deed of bargain and sale shall cease, determine, and be utterly void and of no effect; otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.

IT IS AGREED by and between the said parties that said mortgagor **G.F. Stewart** shall hold and enjoy the said Premises until default of payment shall be made.
