(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Forty-Five Hundred and No/100- - - - - - - - - - - - - - DOLLARS (\$ 4500.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Dix (6%)- - per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, about three miles from Greenville County Courthouse on the South side of an unnamed 20 foot road, leading Mast from White Horse hoad, and being shown as lot No. 1 on Flat of property of 0. T. White made by U. J. Timbe on April 12, 1944, recorded in Flat Book 0, at Page 147, and described as fill axis:

"BEGINNING at a stake on the South side of said 20 foot road 375 foot from White Horse Road, and running thence 3. (0-45 M. 195.5 feet to a stake; thence S. 56-20 E. 50 feet to stake at corner of lot Mo. 2; thence with line of said lot, N. 14-45 E. 242 feet to a stake on said 20 foot road; thence with the Southern side of said 20 foot road, 3. 83-40 W. 100 feet to the beginning corner."

Being the same premises conveyed to the mortgagor by C. T. & T. & Dr. deed dated August 28, 1945, recorded in Volume 200 at Page 345.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it betong the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
