MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

I, Maggie J. Bumby, of Greenville County SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I the said Maggie J. Bumby

in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, in the full and just sum of SEVEN THOUSAND AND NO/100 - - - - - (\$ 7,000.00)

Dollars, with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of SIXTY-FIVE AND NO/100 - - - - - (\$ 65.00) Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Maggie J. Bumby

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me,

the said Maggie J. Bumby in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Greenville Township on the North side of Rogers avenue in a subdivision known as Sans Souci, formerly known as Chelsea, and being shown on plat recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book D, page 5, and being more particularly described as follows:

"BEGINNING at an oak tree on the North side of Rogers avenue, said tree being the Southwest corner of a lot conveyed by Ruth T. Rogers to Madge W. Latimer by deed recorded in Deed Book 200, at page 399, and running thence with the Latimer lot, N. 26 W. 288.4 feet to a stake, Northwest corner of said Latimer lot; thence S. 64-10 W. 61 feet, 7 inches to a stake; thence S. 54-10 W. 47 feet, 4 inches to a stake; thence S. 32-10 W. 33 feet to a stake; thence S. 16-45 W. 110 feet to a stake on said avenue; thence with said avenue, N. 63-48 E. 311 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty. Being the same lot of land conveyed to me by R. C. Giles by deed of even date herewith, not yet recorded."
