

All of that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Greenville Township on the northeast side of Beechwood Avenue and being known and designated as Lot #6 of a subdivision known as Eastover as shown on plat thereof records in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book F at page 42 and having the following metes and bounds to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northeast side of Beechwood Avenue at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 5 and 6, which pin is approximately 300 ft. from the northeastern corner of the intersection of said Beechwood Avenue with Laurens Road and running thence along the line of said Lots Nos. 5 and 6 N. 64-35 E. 155.1 ft. to an iron pin; thence W. 21-49 W. 60 ft. to an iron pin joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 6 and 7, thence along the joint line of said lots S. 62-49 W. 162.5 ft. to the joint corner of said lots on Beechwood Avenue, thence along the line of Beechwood Avenue following the curvature thereof 55 ft. to the beginning corner.
