"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, nituate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, lying near the City of Greer and West therefrom, on the southwestern side of Carolina Avenue, being all of lot No. 20 in Development No. 2 as shown on a plat thereof made for Victor-Monaghan Company, Division of J.P. Stevens & Co., Inc., Greer Plant, and having the following courses and distances: BEGINNING at a point on the Southwestern side of Carolina Avenue at the front joint corner of lots Nos. 20 and 21, and runs thence with the common line of these lots S. 35.21 W. 170 feet to a point on the Northeastern side of a 10-foot alley; thence along the Northeastern side of said alley N. 54.39 W. 105 feet to a point, the joint rear corner of lots Nos. 19 and 20; thence with the common line of lots Nos. 19 and 20 N. 35.21 E. 170 feet to a point on the Southwestern side of Carolina Avenue; thence along the Southwestern side of Carolina Avenue S. 54.39 E. 105 feet to the beginning corner, and being the identical property conveyed to me by Charles W.
