(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Greenville Township, known and designated as the Southwestern portion of Lot No. 49 on a Plat of the Estate of D. W. Cochrane and property of Minnie P. Cochrane, of July 1937 (and revision thereof) by Dalton & Neves, recorded in Plat Book I, Page 92-93 and, having according to said Plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northern side of West Augusta Plate 10 feet South of the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 48 and 49 as shown on original Plat, and running thence N. 52-04 W. 165 feet to an iron pin 10 feet South of the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 48 and 49, as shown on original Plat; thence S. 37-56 W. 36.0 feet to an iron pin on a proposed street; thence S. 16-29 E. 100 feet along said proposed street to a point; thence S. 3-11 E. 127.3 feet; thence along said proposed street to a point on West Augusta Place; thence along the Northwestern side of West Augusta Place N. 37-56 E. 190 feet to a point of beginning."
