All that piece, parcel or lot of land in whick springs Township, Greenville County, state of South Carolina, about one mile southwest from Fallors lying western side of the Lee Road, seing a part of the same property that was conveyed to us by deed recorded in Deed Book 219 at page 19, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:-
