SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I, the said Tom Anderson

in and by my certain note in writing, of even date with these

Presents, I am well and truly indebted to Mrs. J. H. Alewine, G. W. Alewine and Ansel Alewine, partners, trading as Taylors Lumber Company

in the full and just sum of Nineteen Hundred-Fifteen and 97/100 Dollars

to be paid monthly

with interest thereon from October 5, 1949

at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid monthly

until paid in full: all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the south side of the Southern Railway right of way near Taylors, beginning at an iron pin on a proposed thirty foot wide street, corner of Lots numbered 16 and 17 on plat of Sara E. Adams, thence N. 85-00 W. 138.2 feet to point on line at property formerly belonging to H. B. Raines; thence with said line S 12-15 E 128.7 feet to corner of lots Nos. 18 and 19; thence S 85-00 E 172.2 feet to an iron pin on proposed 30 feet wide street; thence with westerly edge of said street as the line N. 5-00 W. 125.7 feet to beginning corner, being lots numbered 17 and 18 on said plat of property of Sara E. Adams and being part of the estate of Alfred Taylor the same conveyed to me by Alfred G.
