"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Grove Township, on the East side of U. S. Highway No. 29, being comprised of lot No. 5 as shown on plat of the property of C. B. Dalton and the additional triangular section purchased from J. W. Rampey and when described together has the following metes and bounds. to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of U.S. Highway No. 29, at joint front corner of lots Nos. 4 and 5, as shown on plat of Dalton property and running thence with line of lot No. 4, S. 65-48 E. 183.4 feet to iron pin; thence with the right-of-way of P & N Railway Company, N. 27-52 E. 112 feet to an iron pin, corner of property owned by J. W. Rampey; thence with line of said property, N. 43-27 W. 181 feet to an iron pin on right-of-way of U.S. Highway No. 29; thence with the Eastern side of said Highway, S. 31-45 W. 135 feet to the point of beginning."
