"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the East side of Fifth Avenue, in Section 2 of Judson Mills Village, known and designated as lot No. 48 as shown on a plat of Section 2 of Judson Mills Village, made by Dalton & Neves, Engrs, in November 1939, which plat is recorded in Plat Book K, at Page 25 and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
