*I, Charles E. Butler of the County and State aforesaid* SEND GREETING:

Whereas, *I*, the said *Charles E. Butler*

in and by *my* certain *promissory* note in writing, of even date with these

Presents, *am* well and truly indebted to *J. H. Collins Jr.*

in the full and just sum of *Fifteen hundred (\$1500.00) Dollars*

, to be paid *one year after date.*

, with interest thereon from *date*

at the rate of *6* per centum per annum, to be computed and paid *Annually*

until paid in full: all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *J. H. Collins Jr.*

*All that piece, parcel or lot of land in O'Neal Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying on west side County road by C.C. dam on middle Riverdam Creek and bounded by lands of Lucea Rose Plumblee and other lands of Lillie Noble Plumblee, being more fully described as follows. Beginning at an iron pin on the west bank of road and a corner of land of Lillie Plumblee and Ellis Peach orchard and running thence North 18-15E-88.0 feet to a stake at white oak; thence South 79-38W-264.0 ft to a stake; thence N 18-15 W-53.5 ft to iron pin, corner of 10 Acre tract of Lucea Rose Plumblee; thence N 73-00E 263.0 ft to beginning pin containing 0.43 Acres more or less being the same conveyed to Lucea Rose Plumblee by Lillie Noble Plumblee by deed dated Feb. 7, 1947, recorded in R.M.C.
