"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of ... Areenville, .. and . in . Chick. Spring Township, being known and designated as Lots Nos. 42, 43 and 44 of a subdivision known as Lincolntown according to a plat thereof prepared by Dalton and Neves, Engineers, June, 1945, said plat being recorded in the R. N. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book S, at page 39, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINLING at an iron pin on the West side of Bell avenue at the joint front corners of Lots Hos. 41 and 42, and running thence along the West side of Bell avenue, S. 10-42 W. 214.5 feet to an iron pin; thence alorg a curved line, the chord of which is S. 48-52 W., 83.7 feet to an iron pin on the North side of Cheek street at the joint corner of Lots Mos. 44 and 45; thence N. 4-00 m. 272.4 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corners of Lots Los. 41 and 42; thunce along the joint line of lots, S. 86-0 M. 83.8 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said promises, or to be installed thereon, which are bereby expressly agreed to be a nart of the realty. Lots los. 42 and 43 were conveyed to us by M. W. More by his deed dated May 17, 1949, recorded in the R. M. C. office for Preserville County in Deed Vol. 381, at page 369, and Lot No. 44 was conveyed to us by h. W. Fore by his deed dated October 7, 1949, recorded in the R. h. C. office for Preenville County in Deed Vol. 393, at page 235."
