"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, on the East side of Spruce Street, being shown as lot No. 6 of Block J, on Plat of Woodville Heights, recorded in Plat Book L, at Pages 14 and 15, and having, according to said Plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Spruce Street, at the joint front corner of lots Nos. 5 and 6 of Block J, and running thence with the line of lot No. 5, S. 86-10 E. 153.1 feet to iron pin on right-of-way of P. & N. Railway; thence with the said right-of-way, N. 3-35 E. 99.8 feet to iron pin, corner of lot No. 7; thence with line of said lot, N. 86-10 W. 156.7 feet to an iron pin on Spruce Street; t ence with the Eastern side of Spruce Street, S. 1-14 W. 100 feet to the point of beginning."
