Now, Know All Men, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville , State of South Carolina: being known and designated as Lot No. 10, Block C, as shown on Map No. 2 of Woodville Heights, recorded in Plat Book L at Pages 14 and 15, and being more particularly described, according to a recent survey of J. C. Hill dated December 27, 1949, as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Western side of Alice Street, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 9 and 10 of Block C, which pin is 120 feet north of the intersection of Alice and Oak Streets, and running thence with the joint line of said lots, N. 87-45 W. 146.6 feet to an iron pin in line of Lot No. 7; thence with the line of Lots Nos. 7 and 15, N. 2-15 E. 60 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 10 and 11; thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 87-45 E. 146.6 feet to an iron pin on the Western side of Alice Street; thence with said Street, S. 2-15 W. 60 feet to the point of beginning.
