E. Robinson, as Trustee under B. M. McGee Trust Deed, his successors and assigns, forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina with the buildings and improvements thereon, being shown as all of Lots 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 on Plat of Property of Catherine Coughlin, prepared by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, in July, 1949, which plat is recorded in Plat Book "X", Page 37, and having when described collectively according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
