(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Two Thousand and No/100- - - - - DOLLARS (\$ 2000.00

), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six (6%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All ~~that~~ ^{those} certain piece^s, parcel^s or lot^s of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, and better known as lots Nos. 4 and 5 in Section D of the property known as Woodville Heights, made by W. J. Riddle, December 1940, and recorded in Plat Book L at Pages 14 and 15, and described as follows:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Spruce Street at the rear corner of lot No. 3 and running thence with the rear lines of lots 3, 2 and 1, S. 80-10 E. 224.4 feet to an iron pin on right-of-way of P & N Railway; thence with said right-of-way, N. 26-40 E. 125 feet to an iron pin, rear corner of lot No. 6; thence with line of lot No. 6, N. 80-10 W. 259.3 feet to an iron pin on Spruce Street; thence with the Eastern side of Spruce Street, S. 9-50 W. 120 feet to the beginning corner."

Being the same premises conveyed to the mortgagor by Jerry Jackson by deed to be recorded.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
