TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

Sans Souci Housing, Inc.

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto H. C. Bates

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of Five Hundred and No/100 - - -

DOLLARS (\$ 500.00),

with interest thereon from date at the rate of Five per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid: On or before August 17, 1950, with interest thereon from date at the rate of five per cent, per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, his heirs, successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, on the Eastern side of Deatur Street and on the Northwestern side of Rutledge Avenue, near the City of Greenville, being shown as lots Nos. 108, 109, 110, 111 and 112, on plat of property of J. P. Rosamond, from a revised plat of Sans Souci Development Company made by Dalton & Neves in April 1931, recorded in Plat Book H at Page 186 in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County and having such metes and bounds as are shown on the said plat. Being the same premises conveyed to the mortgagor by H. C. Bates by deed dated February 17, 1950."

It is understood and agreed that this mortgage is junior in lien to a mortgage this day executed by the mortgagor to Citizens Lumber Company in the original amount of \$22,500.00 .

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
