FOR VALUE RECEIVED, the undersigned The First National Bank of Greenville, S. C., does hereby release, relinquish and forever discharge unto Sophie McAlister Stokes, the undivided one-fifth interest in the premises hereinafter described inherited by her from her father, Charles McAlister, and her mother, Virginia Earle McAlister, from the lien of that certain mortgage covering said premises dated 1st October, 1947, recorded 3 October, 1947, in Volume 370 at Page 127 in the original sum of \$10,800.00.

It is mutually understood and agreed that said mortgage is to remain in full force and effect upon the remaining one-fifth interest owned by the said Sophie McAlister Stokes and Mary McAlister Apperson, being the same interest conveyed to them by Emily McAlister Barnes.
