WHEREAS, I, the said Mamie Lee Burton, am well and truly

indebted in and by my ~~my~~ fifteen certain note.s bearing date the 14th day of April, 1950, in the sum of

TWENTY-FOUR HUNDRED, FORTY-EIGHT AND NO/100 - - - - - (\$2,448.00) - -DOLLARS, payable to the order of THE COUNTY BANK, a corporation with its principal place of business at Greenwood, South Carolina, in fifteen (15) consecutive monthly installments of One Hundred, Sixty-Three and 20/100 (\$163.20) Dollars each, commencing on the 14th day of May, 1950, the final installment being due on the 14th day of July, 1951, together

with interest thereon from maturity at the rate of seven (7%) per cent, per annum, payable annually, and if not so paid to become an interest bearing demand at same rate as principal, and providing for payment of all costs of collection, including an attorneys' fee of ten per cent, of amount due in case said note.s are placed with an attorney for collection, as in and by the said note.s reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said Mamie Lee Burton, for and in consideration of the said debt and note.s aforesaid, and the performance of the covenants hereinafter named and contained, to the said THE COUNTY BANK according to the conditions of the said note.s and also in consideration of the sum of ONE DOLLAR to me in hand well and truly paid by the said THE COUNTY BANK at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said THE COUNTY BANK, its successors and assigns forever, the following:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being designated as a part of Lot No. 20 of Section H, Subdivision known as Woodville Heights, as a Survey made by W. J. Riddle, of date December 1940, and recorded in Plat Book "L" at pages 14 and 15 of the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, to which plat and the record thereof reference is hereby made, and further described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin Twenty (20) feet from the corner of Lot 19 on McDowell Street; thence running in a Westerly direction Seventy (70) feet to the joint corner of Lot 21, thence running in a Northerly direction along line of Lot 21 Four Hundred, Sixty-nine (469) feet to a Branch; thence running in an Easterly direction along the said Branch Seventy (70) feet to an iron pin Twenty (20) feet from the rear corner of Lot 19; thence running in a Southerly direction Four Hundred, Seventy-four (474) feet, more or less, to the Iron pin at the beginning corner.
