MORTGAGE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

, I, D. H. Poole

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto Bank of Travelers Rest

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of **Three Hundred and Thirty-Five & No/10 0**

DOLLARS (\$335.00),

with interest thereon from date at the rate of **Six** per centum per annum, said principal ~~and interest~~ to be repaid: **One year after date**, with interest thereon from date at the rate of **Six** per cent, per annum, to be computed and paid annually

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of **Three (\$3.00) Dollars** to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, his heirs, successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Bates Township, being known **as a part of the D. F. Cunningham tract of land adjoining lands of Earnest Bishop, Pleasant View Baptist Church and others, and described as follows:**

"BEGINNING at a stake in road, at the corner of the church land, and running thence S. 63 W. 8.00 chains to an iron pin; thence N. 34 W. 12.70 chains to a stone on old road at Henry Crewels corner; thence with the old road, N. 80 E. 10.75 chains to an iron pin on a new road; thence with said road, S. 24 E. 9.42 chains to the beginning corner, and containing 9.6 acres, more or less."

Being the same property conveyed to the mortgagor by Ernest Bishop by deed dated May 25, 1944, recorded in Volume 264 at Page 245.
