of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars tomo, the said
in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:
"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon,

situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of ...Greenville, .and .in .Gantt .Town-ship, on the Southwest side of Heather Way and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 123, 124, 125 and 126, of Marshall Forest as shown on plat thereof by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, dated October, 1928, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "H", pages 133 and 134, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southwest side of Heather Way, joint front corner of Lots 122 and 123, and running thence S. 33-58 W. 201.7 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots 122 and 123 and on the Northeast side of a ten foot reservation for pipes and poles; thence along the Northeast side of said reservation and along the rear line of Lots 122, 123, 124 and 125, S. 39-22 E. 104.28 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 126 and 127; thence along the joint line of Lots 126 and 127, N. 33-58 E. 231.5 feet to an iron pin on the Southwestern side of Heather Way, joint front corner of Lots 126 and 127; thence along the Southwestern side of Heather Way, N. 56-02 W. 100 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty. Being the same lots of land conveyed to me by Samuel T. Edwards by his deed dated November 16th, 1949 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 396, at page 150."
